The Malandela's Farm supplies the restaurant with fresh seasonal vegetables and salads. Meat is locally sourced where possible, bread is homemade and the chips are hand-cut. Thursday is Mozambique Prawn Night, and Sunday Lunch Menu includes a Traditional Roast.



Our Contributions

Malandela's centre has always been driven by the family's humanitarian spirit, and as such all businesses at the Centre incorporate social or environmental missions at the heart of their operations.

In addition to business contributions, the centre is also home to NGO's boMake Rural Projects and Moya Centre. Young Heroes is a Swati NGO and has benefited from our annual MTN Bushfire Festival's proceeds for the past 15 years.

MTN Bushfire Beneficiaries

MTN Bushfire supports two beneficiary organisations that stand right at the heart of the festival's social mandate. Young Heroes, assist children and youth orphaned by HIV/Aids, and boMake Rural Projects, who empower women artisans and their communities in rural Eswatini.

Indigenous Tree Nursery

Based on the Malandela's farm, the nursery propagates and sells indigenous trees and shrubs. They have re-populated the farm itself with over 1000 indigenous trees and supplied trees extensively across Eswatini.

boMake Rural Projects - Women's empowerment NGO

boMake Rural Projects is a community-led non-profit organization working with (Gone Rural) women artisans. To date, we have impacted the lives of more than 20,000 community members through our programs focused on education, health and sustainable livelihoods.

Moya Center - Nurturing vulnerable children

Moya Centre aims to strengthen the future of Eswatini through the nurture of children by assisting with educational and psychosocial support programs for orphaned and vulnerable children in the Malkerns community.
